Tips to Prevent Being Burglarized

Here are a few safety tips to consider to reduce your risk of being burglarized.

- Always arm your security system when you leave your home even if it's just for a short time. Burglaries occur at all hours.
- Never call attention to costly new purchases. Flatten boxes with the product information facing in when putting them out for collection.
- Install secure windows and sturdy doors.
- Lock your doors and windows, even while you're in the house. About half of burglars enter through unlocked doors and windows.

- Consider installing bars on windows not protected by your security system or upgrading it to cover all windows.
- Display our decal at all possible points of entry. Security decals and yard signs are a big deterrent.
- Identify and eliminate areas that could easily conceal a burglar while they attempt to gain entry to your home.
- Install motion triggered lighting to surprise and scare off would be burglars.
- Always keep your car doors locked. Theft from unlocked vehicles is extremely common.
